



Minersville Are Youth Soccer Club Player Policy and Code of Conduct

As a representative of the MAYSC, all players shall conduct themselves in accordance with the following rules and regulations:

- A. Players shall make every attempt to attend all scheduled practices and games and shall notify his/ her coach of any inability to attend a practice or game as early as possible.
- B. Players shall attend all practices and games with a positive attitude towards learning.
- C. Players shall be committed to the best interest of their team.
- D. Players must wear the proper MAYSC uniform and equipment required by MAYSC and/or its affiliated organizations.
- E. Players must represent MAYSC in a positive manner by conducting themselves in a manner promoting good sportsmanship at both practices and games.
- F. Players shall refrain from becoming involved in any confrontational situations (including being loud and abusive) at practices or games.
- G. Players shall promote the emotional and physical well-being of the players ahead of any personal desires.
- H. Players shall treat other players, coaches, officials and spectators with respect regardless of race, creed, color, sex or ability.
- I. Players must show respect towards game officials, coaches and MAYSC Board members in their language, attitude, behavior and mannerisms. Under NO circumstances shall a player verbally or physically abuse another player, a coach, a referee, or a spectator. Any infraction to this rule or any other questionable conduct of a player should be reported to an MAYSC Board member immediately.
- J. Players shall adhere to ALL Soccer rules and codes enforced by the governing bodies of soccer to which MAYSC is affiliated.
- K. Be a positive Role Model to all soccer players with whom you come in contact with.

It is so noted that any Player that fails to abide by the aforementioned policy and code of conduct, may be subject to disciplinary action. This action could include but not limited to the following: verbal warning, written warning, player removal from practice or game, game suspension, season suspension, or disbarment. These actions may not be necessarily taken in an escalating manner and MAYSC Board reserves the right to select and apply any penalty dependent on the situation.
